### Our logo


#### Using the logo

Our logo, pictured to the right, shows light and dark colourways.

#### Exclusion zone

The clear space around the logo is half of the complete height of the logo ("x"). Please ensure nothing encroaches into this space.


**Remember:** We ask that you do not squash or stretch our logo and please avoid placing the logo closely to other design elements which may distract from it.

#### Our brand icon usage


Our brand icon must not be used as a main feature or asset. It may be regarded instead as an icon.

It can therefore be used like other icons as shown in the examples on the left.

It must never be used as a frame or overlay, as shown in the examples on the right.

**For example** we could use it as a CTA to find out more information or a contents page anchor point in presentations.


For example we do not use the icon as a framing device or content box. As a rule the icon should take up no more than 5% of your design or asset



A use example for the icon could a CTA or information point.



Use the icon minimally. As a rule the icon should not take up more that 5% of your design. As you can see here it's used in the top right as a contents page anchor for each presentation slide.




**Don't**Do not frame content using the icon. Do not crop icon.



**Don't**Do not overlay or frame icon with imagery.





In the same way as our iconography, our illustrative style is clean and simple.


Therefore, please try to emulate this simplicity consistently when creating new illustrations.consistency within the same document.
